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BY THE NUMBERS

- 0.78** Average seconds of footage per day, per animator.
- 3** Tons of Jesmonite plasters used to texture sets.
- 4** Seconds of cut-in footage each animator shot per week.
- 8** Puppets created for each tribe member.
- 10** Weeks to create every individual puppet.
- 18** Dug puppets created.
- 23** Different modelmakers used to make puppets.
- 29** Animators working on studio floor at production peak.
- 30** Months it took to make all those puppets.
- 40** Years that Aardman has been in existence.
- 60** Trees made (each of which took about a week to make).
- 273** Puppets required to make Early Man.
- 500** Square meters of artificial grass used for football pitch sets.
- 3,000** ... Interchangeable mouths created by hand for the characters.



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
