

Likes: Bananas & having a swingin' good time


Dislikes: Not knowing the secret of man's 'red flower' -- fire




"It's a mancub...a delicious mancub!"

until he must finally take this tiger on to protect his best buddy, Mowgli. To this bored villain, such a challenge seems so delightful!












THE ELEPHANTS
