

Epic Hummingbird Feeder

Follow the simple instructions to create your hummingbird feeder. Just remember to ask a parent for help!

Make a hummingbird feeder from a plastic bottle



waterproof glue



water bottle



nail



paint



straw / wire



string



nectar

- ★ In a clean plastic bottle, make a hole about 1 inch (2.5 cm) from the cap.
- ★ Push a plastic straw through the hole.
- ★ Fill the bottle with water, turn it upside down, and adjust the straw until water fills it up without spilling out.
- ★ Empty the bottle and glue the straw in place with waterproof glue.
- ★ Tie a string around the bottle to hang it or use wire if you're using a larger bottle, and add a circle of red cardboard around the straw to mimic a flower.
- ★ When you're finished, place your hummingbird feeder in a shady area, keeping an eye out for a place close to trees or bushes where hummingbirds can hide and rest between visits.



Nectar for your feeder

- ★ To make hummingbird nectar, mix $\frac{1}{2}$ cup of sugar with 1 cup of hot water.
- ★ Stir until the sugar dissolves. Add 1 cup of cold water.
