

RUBBLE'S PUPPY CHOW RECIPE

S'mores-style puppy chow made with rice cereal, chocolate, peanut butter, mini marshmallows, and PAW Patrol Graham Snacks. This yummy snack mix is perfect for a PAW Patrol party!

INGREDIENTS:

- 9 cups rice cereal squares
- 1 ½ cups chocolate chips, divided
- ½ cup creamy peanut butter
- 1 ½ cups powdered sugar
- 3 cups PAW Patrol
 Graham Snacks (about 7-8 individual snack packets)
- 1 cup mini marshmallows

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Place the cereal in a large mixing bowl.
- 2. Place 1 cup of chocolate chips and peanut butter in medium saucepan. Cook over medium-low heat, stirring frequently until chocolate is melted. Pour chocolate mixture over cereal in mixing bowl and stir until cereal is evenly coated with chocolate.
- 3. Place cereal in large zipper bag and add powdered sugar. Seal bag and shake until cereal is evenly coated with powdered sugar. Spread cereal onto wax paper lined baking sheet to dry.
- 4. After chocolate has dried, toss cereal into large serving bowl with PAW Patrol graham snacks, mini marshmallows, and remaining ½ cup of chocolate chips.

Chickaletta's Chicken Nuggets Recipe

These delicious homemade nuggets are way better than the drive-through! Perfect for a PAW Patrol party, lunch idea, or afterschool snack.

What you need:

- Cooking oil
- 1 lb. boneless, skinless chicken breasts, cubed
- 1 cup all-purpose flour, divided
- 1/3 cup cornstarch ½ teaspoon paprika
- ½ teaspoon pepper ½ teaspoon salt
- 1/2 teaspoon garlic powder
- 1 cup soda water

Instructions:

- 1. Add cooking oil to a deep skillet and heat to 350 degrees.
- 2. Chop the chicken pieces in a food processor until finely minced.
- 3. Place ¼ cup of the flour into shallow bowl. Form the chicken into small nugget-sized patties (it's helpful to have some flour on your hands while forming the patties) then dredge both sides in flour. Set the nuggets on waxed paper and continue until you've used all the chicken.
- 4. Mix the remaining ¾ cup of flour, cornstarch, salt,pepper, garlic powder, and paprika together in a medium-sized bowl. Add the soda water and stir until the batter is blended completely.
- 5. Dip the chicken nuggets into the batter, shaking off the excess batter before adding to the hot oil. Repeat with the remaining chicken nuggets. Cook, flipping with tongs once or twice until golden brown on both sides and completely cooked. Drain on a paper towel lined plate. Serve with your favorite dipping sauces.



PUP-TASTIC PUPCORN AND PINK PUNCH RECIPE

Cool off this summer with a colorful, gluten-free snack and a yummy pink lemonade!

What you need:

- White popcorn kernels
- Red, yellow, and light blue candy melts
- Red, yellow, blue construction paper/cardstock
- 2 cups freshly squeezed lemon juice (12 lemons)
- 1 ½ cups sugar (or sugar substitute)
- 9 cups water, divided
- 1 cup cran-raspberry juice
- Scissors Double-sided tape

Instructions:


- 1. Pop the popcorn using an air popper. Separate into 3 bowls.
- 2. One color at a time, melt some candy melts in microwave per package directions. Toss one color of the melted candy coating in each of the bowls with the popcorn. Spread each color of popcorn out into a single layer on separate pieces of waxed paper to dry.
- 3. While popcorn is drying, cut construction paper into squares, then cut squares in half diagonally. Roll into a cone shape. Secure with double-sided tape.
- 4. Fill cones with popcorn of same color and display in box or cone holder.
- 5. Bring lemon juice, sugar, and 1 cup of water to a boil in a medium saucepan over medium-high heat. Simmer until the sugar is dissolved then remove from heat. Cool to room temperature.
- 6. In a beverage dispenser or large pitcher, mix lemon juice mixture with the remaining 8 cups of water and cran-raspberry juice.

 Chill until ready to serve or serve with ice.

Instructions for making the game:

- 1. Tape the box shut, then use the template to draw the shape of a paw print on one side.
- 2. Cut out the paw print from the box.
- 3. Wrap the box in blue wrapping paper and secure with tape (like you're wrapping a present).
- 4. Cut out the paw print holes.

How to play:

- Two players stand at the same spot at a distance away from the box and take turns tossing bean bags towards the box.
- Players earn 1 point for each bag that lands on top of the box and 3 points for each bag that lands in a hole. The first player to reach 21 points wins.




