# DIY PHOTO FRAME



## SUPPLIES

- 8x10 picture frame with the glass removed
- Decorative hinge clip
- 5 in. square photo of your choice
- “We’re Creepy and We’re Kooky” and photo square files
- White, black, purple cardstock paper
- Black adhesive vinyl
- Transfer tape
- Cricut cutting machine and cutting accessories (mat, weeder, scraper)
- Double-sided tape
- Hot glue gun and hot glue sticks

## INSTRUCTIONS

1. Load the project files into Cricut Design Space or [access the project here](#).
2. Size the “We’re Creepy and We’re Kooky” phrase to 6.5 in. width, then cut it out on black adhesive vinyl with the Cricut.
3. Carefully weed the excess pieces off of the white backing, anything that is not part of the phrase, and set the phrase aside.
4. Cut out two squares with the Cricut to use as the backing for your photo. If using a photo sized at 5 in. width, cut a purple square at 5.5 in. width and a black square at 5.25 in. width on cardstock paper.
5. Use double-sided tape to stick the photo and backing squares together, stacking the photo on top of the black cardstock square. Next, place that piece on top of the purple cardstock square, attaching it with tape.
6. Cut out an 8x10 white rectangle with the Cricut to use as the background for the frame.
7. Place a piece of transfer tape on top of the “We’re Creepy and We’re Kooky” phrase, then use the scraper to place the transfer tape securely to the letters.
8. Carefully pull the phrase off of the white backing with it now sticking to the transfer tape.
9. Center the phrase at the top center of the white cardstock background, then press the phrase to the paper and secure it by running the scraper over the top of the transfer tape. Carefully pull back the transfer tape, leaving the phrase in place on the white cardstock paper.
10. Use hot glue to attach the decorative hinge clip to the white cardstock paper, gluing it directly below the center of the vinyl phrase.
11. Once the hot glue has dried, secure the photo with the paired backing between the fasteners of the hinge clip.
12. Stick the assembled white cardstock piece into the frame and return the frame backing to keep it in place.
