Just as Belle loves reading a good book, try these fun ideas to share the joy of reading with friends and family:

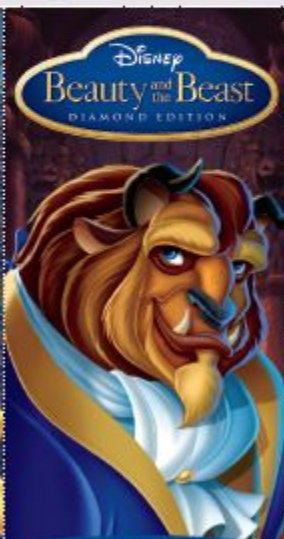

Through courage and compassion, this bookworm beauty sees past The Beast's gruff manners and finds his true inner heart.

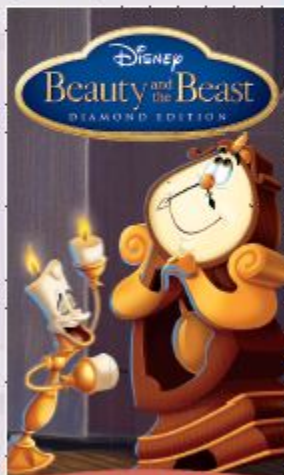

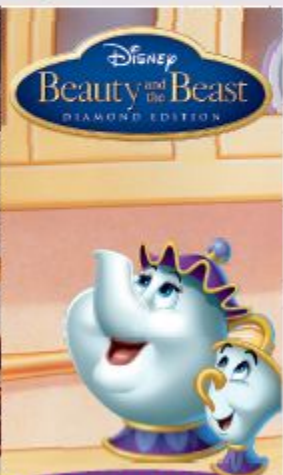


LUMIERE & COGSWORTH
