Pachyrhinosaurus literally means "Thick-nosed lizard". They roamed the Earth 73 million years, and became extinct 69 million years ago.

The Dark Prince is the villain of our movie. A smart, fast and terrifying predator.

Gorgosaurus is also known as "Fierce Lizard". They were active 76 million years, and died out 75 million years ago. They grew 50kg a year, the weight of a person.

Alex is Patchi's unlikely friend and ally who has a tendency to show up at the right place at the right time.

Named after palaeontologist Alexander Wetmore. They could fly at 45kph and had modified wrist joints so that the wing could fold against the body, like modern day birds.
