

#### REMINDERS

Only a grown-up should do any cutting.

#### **WHAT YOU'LL NEED**

- 8 ½" x 11" cardstock (we recommend 110-pound paper for best results)
- Scissors
- Cutting knife
- Ruler
- Glue stick
- Toothpick or needle
- Elastic string about 12 inches long (prepare as many pieces as you have partygoers)

#### **HOW TO MAKE IT**

- Print out the following pages, printing out as many hats as you have partygoers.
  Have a grown-up use a cutting knife to very lightly score along dashed lines -- using
  a ruler to ensure edges are straight -- and to cut slits along all black and white
  dotted lines.
- To assemble Goldie's Party Hat, insert tab A into the previously cut slit along edge.
- To assemble Goldie's Bow, glue tab A to 1 and tab B to 2. Wrap tab C around the center of the bow and glue to 3. Glue the backside of the completed bow to 4 on Goldie's Party Hat.



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



- To assemble Bear's Party Hat, insert tab A into the previously cut slit along edge.
- To assemble Bear's Ears, fold each Ear in half along the dashed line and glue the backsides together. Insert the B tabs into the previously cut white slits on the sides of Bear's Party Hat.
- 6. To assemble the Star Topper, fold each of the halves of the Star Topper along the dashed lines as shown in the diagram. Glue tab A to 1, B to 2, C to 3, D to 4, E to 5, F to 6, G to 7, H to 8, I to 9, and J to 10.
- 7. To assemble the Star Hat, take the white and grey Z tab strips located at the base of the assembled Star Topper and place them in the hole at the top of the Star Hat. Wrap the top of the Star Hat around the base of the Star Topper. Insert tab A on the Star Hat into the previously cut slit along edge. Glue the Z tabs to the inside of the Star Hat to secure the Star Topper in place atop the Star Hat.
- 8. To complete assembly of each Party Hat, have a grown-up use a toothpick or needle to poke out the small black holes at the base of each hat. Thread each end of a piece of elastic string through the holes, knotting each end so the string does not slip through either hole. Tuck string underneath child's chin until snug to secure hat into place.



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
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














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
