

DR. DRAKKEN MILKSHAKE

INGREDIENTS

- 4 ounces dark chocolate, melted
- Blue food gel dye
- Two wood skewers
- Blue sour candy strips
- Blue sour candy chews
- Blue cotton candy
- Additional blue candies
- Whipped cream
- 3 scoops vanilla ice cream
- 1 cup milk
- $1\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoons vanilla



INSTRUCTIONS

- Fold the sour candy strips and place onto the wooden skewer. Add a sour candy chew on the end. Set aside.
- On parchment, use a small amount of the melted chocolate to create a scar shape. Place in the freezer to set.
- Roll the rim of the glass in the rest of the melted chocolate. Let set.
- Once the chocolate has set, add drips of blue food gel dye on the inside of the glass to create blue veins like Dr. Drakken's. Add a green candy on the outside of the glass to look like Drakken's collar. Set the glass aside.
- In a blender, add the ice cream, milk, vanilla, and blue food gel dye. Blend until combined.
- Pour the milkshake into the prepped glass and top with whipped cream.
- Decorate with cotton candy, candy skewers, and other blue candies.
- Place the chocolate scar on top and serve.
