

DIY Still Puppets



FREDDY THE FLAMINGO INSTRUCTIONS

- Cut an oval shape with a slightly smaller bottom from a red paper square.
- Cut a half oval from an orange paper square and glue to the bottom of Freddy's face.
- Cut out a football shape from a brown paper square for Freddy's beak.
- Cut out two white ovals about the size of the beak, two slightly smaller brown ovals, two even smaller black ovals and two tiny white circles, and glue them together (like pictured) for the eyes.
- Glue each eye onto the top of the red head and glue the brown beak on top of the orange half circle.
- Cut out one large feather and two tiny feathers from a red paper square and glue the large one to the back top of the head and the tiny ones to each back lower side.
- Cut a long neck from another red paper square and glue to the back bottom of Freddy.
- · Glue a craft stick to the bottom back of Freddy's neck.

SUPPLIES

- Craft sticks
- 5" x 5" paper square stack
- Black permanent marker
- Pencil
- Hot glue & hot glue gun
- Scissors
- Googly eyes





DIY Still Puppets



PIP THE PENGUIN INSTRUCTIONS

- Carefully cut out a half oval shape from a black paper square for Pip's head.
- Draw the face of Pip onto a white paper square and cut out with scissors.
- Glue the white face onto the black head.
- Cut out a 1" triangle orange beak and carefuly round the bottom and top, and glue to the center of the white face.
- Cut out two blue half circles about the size of the beak and glue one to the top of Pip's head, with the rounded side facing up. Glue the second half upside down and tilted on the bottom of the first blue half circle to look like a hat.
- Glue two googly eyes onto Pip's face above the beak.
- Use the black permanent marker to draw on the mouth, eyebrows, and a line on the hat.
- · Glue a craft stick to the bottom back of Pip.

- Craft sticks
- 5" x 5" paper square stack
- Black permanent marker
- Pencil
- Hot glue & hot glue gun
- Scissors
- Googly eyes
