SQUARE BUBBLE

Adult supervision required.

Supplies:

Pipe Cleaners Straws Scissors Dish Soap Glycerin Bubble Wand

Instructions:

- 1) Use the scissors to cut the six pipe cleaners and straws in half.
- 2) Twist three of the pipe cleaners together at the end to make a triangular, pyramid-shaped component. You'll end up with four, three-legged pieces.
- 3) Slide a piece of straw onto each wire leg. Some of the pipe cleaner should stick out of the straw on each leg.
- 4) Build the cube by twisting the pipe cleaner ends on one component to the ends on another component. Connect all the legs until the cube is complete. Make it as even a shape as you can.
- 5) Mix the bubble solution: 2 gallons water, ¼ cup liquid dish soap, glycerin.
- 6) Dip the cube shape into the solution. Let it sit in the solution for a few seconds, then lift it out by holding on to two corners. Place it on a flat surface to keep the bubble film stable.
- 7) Use a bubble wand to blow a bubble and drop it into the center of the square, where it will "magically" transform into a cube.

BENDING LIGHT

Supplies:

Plastic Bottle Screwdriver Masking Tape Cooking Pan Funnel Laser Pointer

Instructions:

- 1) Poke a hole into the middle of a plastic bottle with a screwdriver.
- 2) Cover the hole with a piece of masking tape so it doesn't leak right when you add water.
- 3) Place the bottle in a cooking pan and use a funnel to pour tap water into the bottle. Fill it completely to the top and leave the lid off.
- 4) Aim the beam of the laser pointer horizontally through the bottle from the opposite side as the hole.
- 5) Remove the tape and watch the light bend as the water pours out.

LEVITATION

Supplies:

Tinsel PVC Pipe

Instructions:

- 1) Take the strands of tinsel and bundle them together by tying the ends of the tinsel into knots. The knots should be five to seven inches apart.
- 2) Cut off the extra tinsel on the ends.
- 3) Rub the PVC pipe on the hair at the back of your neck for about 15 seconds. Wool clothing also works if you don't have hair.
- 4) Hold the pipe completely vertical in one hand. With the other hand, hold the tinsel above the pipe end.
- 5) Drop the tinsel so it falls onto the end of the pipe.
- 6) Like magic, the tinsel will spread out into a ball-like orb and float above the pipe. You can now shift the pipe around, "balancing" the floating orb above the pipe.
