

## **APPA APPLE DOG TREATS**

## **INGREDIENTS & SUPPLIES**

- 2 cups oat flour
- ½ cup plain applesauce
- 3 tbsp creamy peanut butter
- Baking sheet
- Parchment paper
- Mixing bowl and spoon
- Measuring cups and spoons
- Cooling rack

## INSTRUCTIONS

- Preheat oven to 350 degrees F. Line a baking sheet with parchment paper.
- In a mixing bowl, combine the oat flour, applesauce, and peanut butter until well-mixed. The dough will be very thick, like play dough.
- 3. Using your hands, form the dough into balls and flatten. Pinch the top corners upward to create Appa's horns, and add a separation at the bottom-center to resemble his legs and feet. Place on the prepared baking sheet about an inch apart (the dough will not spread while baking, so the treats can be placed close together).
- 4. Bake in the pre-heated oven for 18-20 minutes for slightly soft treats, or 25-30 minutes for extra crunchy treats (flipping the treats halfway through the cooking time if you're doing the longer time; if you're using the longer cooking time, check the treats every few minutes to make sure the horns don't become burned).
- Cool treats on a wire rack completely before storing in an airtight container.
