

KRABBY PATTY CUPCAKES

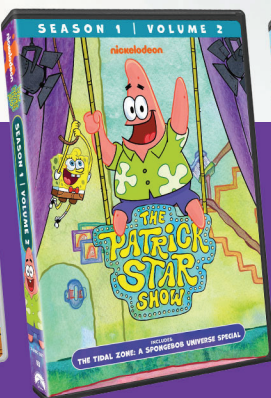
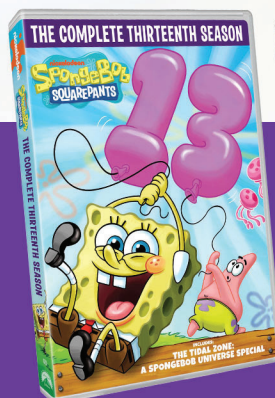


INGREDIENTS

- 1 (15.25-oz) package yellow cake mix • 1 (18-oz) package chocolate brownie mix • Orange fruit taffy candy squares (such as Starburst), unwrapped
- 1 cup + 3 tablespoons water (or as called for on the cake and brownie mix packages), divided
- 1/2 cup + 2/3 cup vegetable oil (or as called for on the cake and brownie mix packages), divided
- 5 eggs (or as called for on the cake and brownie mix packages), divided • Shredded coconut • Green food coloring • Marshmallows • Crispy rice cereal
- Strawberry fruit strips • Red cake decorating • Yellow cake decorating • Green gummy fruit ring candy (such as Lifesavers Gummies) unwrapped

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Make yellow cake mix into 24 cupcakes per package directions and let cool completely. Cut cupcakes in half horizontally to make Krabby Patty “buns” and separate tops from bottoms. (Note: You will have extra buns; feel free to frost and enjoy them however you want!)
2. Make brownie mix in 9”x13” pan lined with parchment paper per package directions and let cool completely. Remove parchment paper from pan and cut brownies into as many circles as you can using 2.5” cookie cutter to create Krabby Patty “burger patties” (you should be able to get 10-12 patties).
3. Layer brownie circle on top of bottom buns.
4. Mix shredded coconut with green food coloring in small bowl to make “lettuce.” Sprinkle on top of patties.
5. Lay pieces of orange Starburst candies on microwave-safe plate. Microwave for 5-10 seconds to soften candies, then flatten two together to make larger square using base of mason jar or small bowl to make “cheese slices.” Repeat for desired amount of burgers, then add pieces on top of lettuce.
6. Cut marshmallows into thin, round slices to make “onions.” Layer on top of cheese.
7. Use cap of plastic drink bottle to cut round circles into fruit strips to make “tomatoes.” Add to burgers on top of onions.
8. Next, pipe red cake decorating icing “ketchup” followed by yellow cake decorating icing “mustard” on top of onion layer (in that order).
9. Add green gummy rings “pickle slices” on top of the mustard.
10. Add top bun on top of burger toppings. Add small yellow icing dots on top of buns, and attach pieces of rice cereal to icing to look like “sesame seeds.”
