CARDBOARD TRUCKS

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Remove any packaging from box.
- Paint outside of box in your choice of PAW Patrol color or cover with construction paper.
- Paint paper plates black or cut out black construction paper into large circles to make tires.
- Paint front top flap (short end) white for the windshield.
- Take the two long flaps and bend the corner inward at an angle to glue on the windshield.
 For best results, use a hot glue gun to glue the two sections to the back of the windshield flap.
- Using more paint or construction paper add details (ladder, radiator, side windows).
- Glue the wheels to the sides of the box near the bottom.
- 8. Poke holes in each corner at the top.
- Put a piece of string or twine from front to back and tie. Repeat for other side.
- 10. Cut a large hole in the bottom of the box.
- 11. Cut out PAW Patrol logos and glue to the vehicle.

- 1 Large Cardboard Boxes
- Paint or Construction Paper
- Glue
- Glue Gun (optional)
- Paper Plates or Black
 Construction Paper
- Twine, String, or Ribbon
- Scissors
